

## proactive Camp @ The Lodge

### Welcome to Camp at The Lodge

The Awesome camp at Manor Lodge school Run by Proactive Events. Please read this for important information regarding what is needed and how camp will run and frequently asked questions for when you attend.

The camp has been designed to fit in with the surroundings of the school and excellent outdoor spaces. There will be inside provisions for some activities and for bad weather. However, most activities will take place outside and through most weather conditions.

Children will need to bring extra Items to camp, please see below –

- Suitable clothing for outside activities
- Snacks/ A balanced Pack Lunch **Nut Free**
- Water Bottle – refillable
- Medication if needed which must be labelled including dosage
- Sun Cream and Hat
- Waterproofs

There will be activities, special days and events where children may need to bring additional clothing, but these reminders will be sent out nearer the time or on display at the registration table.

**All Registration and Pick up will be done from the car park, adopting the Manor Lodge drop off and pick up system.**

A weekly and daily plan of activities and events will be available on request.

Children will be split into different camps according to their Year and age.

For the summer camp children will be placed into the camps for the year group they are moving into in September.

The camp will be working alongside Manor lodge School ideals and policies. There is a link to these policies on the website.

Before attending camp, a medical form **MUST** be accepted on the booking form, further to that any child with an ongoing medical condition must check in with the primary first aider on the morning of their first day of attending.

All staff will have a DBS, they will be qualified in their fields and trained in the area in which they work. The leaders will all be over 18 and some of the staff will be made up of teachers.

The camp will be running to strict ratios. This will of course mean that staff are assigned to numbers. Once a camp is full there will not be any other spaces available.

Children will be encouraged to try new activities, they will be pushed and motivated to come out of their comfort zones at times. However, each child is different, and this will be acknowledged. For early years diary's will be kept with observations of individual children's behaviours recorded.

Photos will be taken on camp for school and camp use only. No pictures of your children will ever be put on social media unless agreed.

This camp will enrich your child with different experiences and outside activities. Children will help to mould their own style of camp and the whole camp will be inclusive and to cater for each child's needs.

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## Daily Diary Registrations drop off and Pickup

### Drop Off

8.45 – 9.15am (Doors open 8.30am)

### LUNCH IS FROM 12.00

### Pick Up

3.30 – 4.00PM (Children will be ready from 3.30pm)

There will be 2 sessions in the AM and 2 Sessions in the PM

These sessions will be broken up with breaks for drinks and snacks, so pack plenty in with their lunch. Taps to refill their water will be available the whole time children are on camp

On the first day a steward will be on the front gate as depending on a building works taking place changes maybe made for drop off and pickup. The children's safety is most important so if any changes are made it has been made for them. Please forgive us if this causes a little longer on pick up.

Activities will vary day to day catering for all children within their group. Once the day starts children will continue with their group until the day ends. This is once again because of the strict Staff ratios in place to ensure the children's safety and enjoyment during the session and the group they are within.

There will be a designated First aider, Fire Marshal and Safeguarding officer as part of the senior team on camp. A weekly and daily plan of activities and events will be available on request but can change at late notice.

At Lunchtime children in there groups will will assigned an area in which they will keep their bags and belongings throughout the day. This maybe outside but in shade and with a shelter. There will be staff available throughout the day for toilet and water runs. Even though the children attend the school they will be escorted for toilet breaks in groups.

Even though we hope Covid is now in the past we will still be making sure the children keep hands clean and areas will be cleaned and sanitised regularly.

The camp is Physical and will be introducing some fun activities and a diary of those activities will be located at the registration desk for you to see.
